oh the trees nothing but white and green as far as you can see remember lyuba oh my lovely childhood waking up to happiness looking out at blossom and trees and there they are the same trees the same blossom after cruel winter warmth and light and feeling in his masterpiece the cherry orchard chekhov maintains an exquisite balance between elegiac celebration of the romance of the past as embodied in the cherry orchard in full bloom and the awesome prescience of what is so soon to overwhelm russia revolution the themes are majestic and yet at the centre of the play is ranévskaya a tragic woman who lacks adroitness for survival in a changing world but who has one asset a capacity for love it is her solution and chekhov s this new version of the cherry orchard by pam gems opened at the crucible sheffield in march 2007

hear what i have to say about the cherry orchard because it is mine i say bring it down tear it down smash it down and tear it down watch watch just you watch i will build holiday villas as far as the eye can see i will build a place for everyone to come and enjoy for the future and this will be the future a new life a new way of life here come now and play play play get the band to play ranyevskaya returns more or less bankrupt after ten years abroad luxuriating in her fading moneyed world and regardless of the increasingly hostile forces outside she and her brother snub the lucrative scheme of lopakhin a peasant turned entrepreneur to save the family estate in so doing they put up their lives to auction and seal the fate of the beloved orchard set at the very start of the twentieth century the cherry orchard captures a poignant moment in russia s history as the country rolls inexorably towards 1917 the cherry orchard by anton chekhov in a version by andrew upton premiered at the national theatre london in may 2011

naive and unrealistic russian landed gentry fail to comprehend approaching financial collapse

four teenagers grow inseparable in the last days of the soviet union but not all of them will live to see the new world arrive in this powerful debut novel loosely based on anton chekhov s the cherry orchard spectacular intensely evocative and

gorgeously written will fill readers eyes with tears and wonder minneapolis star tribune one of the best books of the year new york post coming of age in the ussr in the 1980s best friends anya and milka try to envision a free and joyful future for themselves they spend their summers at anya s dacha just outside of moscow lazing in the apple orchard listening to queen songs and fantasizing about trips abroad and the lives of american teenagers meanwhile anya s parents talk about world war ii the blockade and the hardships they have endured by the time anya and milka are fifteen the soviet empire is on the verge of collapse they pair up with classmates trifonov and lopatin and the four friends share secrets and desires argue about history and politics and discuss forbidden books but the world is changing and the fleeting time they have together is cut short by a sudden tragedy years later anya returns to russia from america where she has chosen a different kind of life far from her family and childhood friends when she meets lopatin again he is a smug businessman who wants to buy her parents dacha and cut down the apple orchard haunted by the ghosts of her youth anya comes to the stark realization that memory does not fade or disappear rather it moves us across time connecting our past to our future joys to sorrows inspired by anton chekhov s the cherry orchard kristina gorcheva newberry s the orchard powerfully captures the lives of four soviet teenagers who are about to lose their country and one another and who struggle to survive to save their friendship to recover all that has been lost

while the influence of chekhov in modern theater worldwide and especially in america has been immense translations into english have tended to be too literary and have not communicated the full emotional power and precise attention to detail of chekhov s russian milton ehre began translating chekhov s plays to provide professional theaters with performance texts that capture the feel and rhythms of spoken rather than written language chekhov for the stage is the first publication of his revised versions of the three sisters uncle vanya the cherry orchard and the sea gull ehre s sensitive renderings of these classics make this volume the translation of choice for performers and directors teachers and the general reading public

anton chekhov was a master whose daring work revolutionized theatre robert burstein declared that there are none who bring the drama to a higher realization of its human role in the cherry orchard his last full length play an impoverished landowning family is unable to face the fact that their estate is about to be auctioned off lopakhin a local merchant presents numerous options to save it including cutting down their prized cherry orchard but the family is stricken with

denial the cherry orchard charts the precipitous descent of a wealthy family and in the process creates a bold meditation on social change and bourgeois materialism

the cherry orchard was written by chekhov as a comedy but directed by stanislavski as a tragedy on its premier the play has maintained the dual nature of these intentions ever since an aristocratic family return to their estate on the eve of auction though alternatives present themselves the family is apathetic and their property is sold the play addresses the vast changes to the russian social casts at the time and the general cultural futility experienced by the aristocracy and bourgeoisie in their shifting roles

although younger than most european theatrical traditions the russian professional theater has generated an exciting body of criticism and theory which until recently has remained unknown or nearly inaccessible in the west this anthology presents a selection of important russian writing on the aesthetics of drama and the theater from 1828 to 1914 the focus of these essays most published here for the first time in english is on the so called crisis in the theater of 1904 to 1914 a lively debate between the symbolists and the naturalists that evoked brilliant polemic writing from meyerhold bely bryusov and others along with chekhov s amusing critique of sarah bernhardt monstrously facile and ivanov s abstruse analysis of the essence of tragedy the essays form a running commentary on the development of the russian theater pushkin on his predecessors gogol on his own work belinsky on gogol sleptsov on ostrovsky and leskov bely on chekhov s the cherry orchard enervated people trying to forget the terror of life the symbolists on one another each selection is printed in its entirety with extensive notes and a lengthy introduction places all the pieces within their historical and cultural contexts to comprise a brief history of russian dramatic theory before the revolution this volume is essential reading for all who wish to extend their knowledge of the russian contribution to theatrical history theory and criticism

despite the controversy generated by its paradoxical nature however the cherry orchard has become a milestone in twentieth century drama

here is one of the most important surviving works of pre columbian civilization *rabinal achi* a mayan drama set a century before the arrival of the spanish produced by the translator of the best selling *popol vuh* the first direct translation into english from quiché maya based on the original text *rabinal achi* is the story of city states war and nobility of diplomacy mysticism and psychic journeys cawek of the forest people has been captured by man of rabinal who serves a ruler named lord five thunder cawek is a renegade a warrior who has inflicted much suffering on rabinal yet he is also the son of the lord of the allied city of quiché a noble who once fought alongside man of rabinal the drama presents the confrontation between the two during the trial of cawek who defies his captors and proudly accepts death by beheading dennis tedlock's translation is clear and vivid more than that it is rooted in an understanding of how the play is actually performed despite being banned for centuries by spanish authorities it survived in actual practice and is still performed in the town of rabinal today tedlock's photographs and diagrams accompany the text capturing nuances not apparent in the dialogue alone he also provides an introduction and commentary that explain the historical events compressed into the play the spanish influence on the mayan dramatic tradition and the cultural and religious world preserved in this remarkable play *rabinal*

achi ranks as a classic of mayan literature and a rare window on a world that had yet to be invaded by europeans dennis tedlock brings this drama to life in all its richness
